Treaty on the Eurasian Economic Union (EAEU), Article 4:

Tegucigalpa Protocol, Article 3:

The main objectives of the Union shall be as follows:

to create proper conditions for sustainable economic development of the Member States in order to improve the living standards of their population; [...].

The fundamental objective of the Central American Integration system is:

[...] to promote, in a harmonious and balanced manner, the sustained economic, social, cultural and political development of the Members States and of the region as a whole;









health, logistics, finance, ecology


