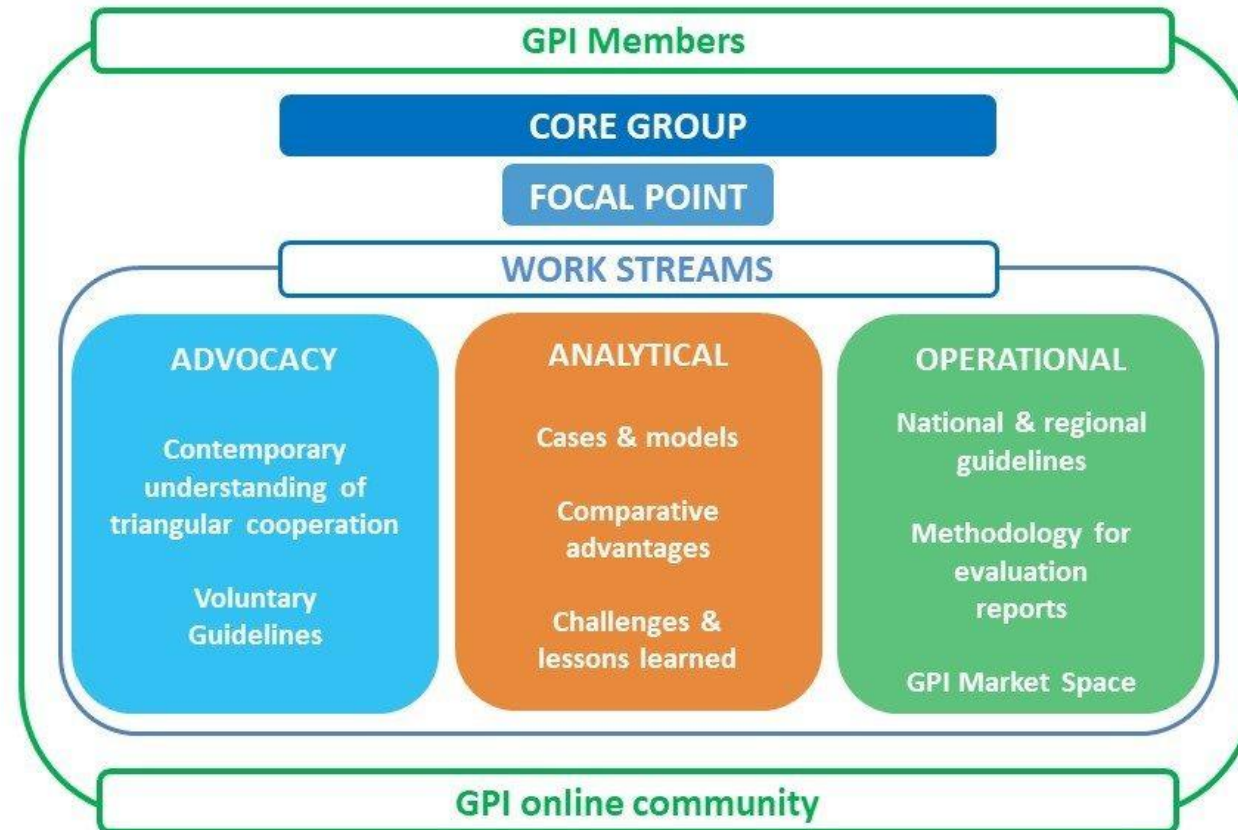
Five pillars of OECD work on triangular co-operation

Pillar	Activities
Analysis	Assessing the successes and challenges in triangular co-operation.
Data and evidence	Collecting data, including through an online project repository , project documents, evaluation reports and other publications on how triangular co-operation works.
Dialogue	Facilitating the discussion of triangular co-operation actors in international meetings.
Policy support	Producing tools and guidelines; supporting countries and stakeholders to reinforce their systems to enable effective triangular co-operation.
Advocacy	Promoting triangular co-operation globally and as a core group member of the Global Partnership Initiative (GPI) on Effective Triangular Co-operation.



Global Partnership Initiative (GPI) on Effective Triangular Co-operation

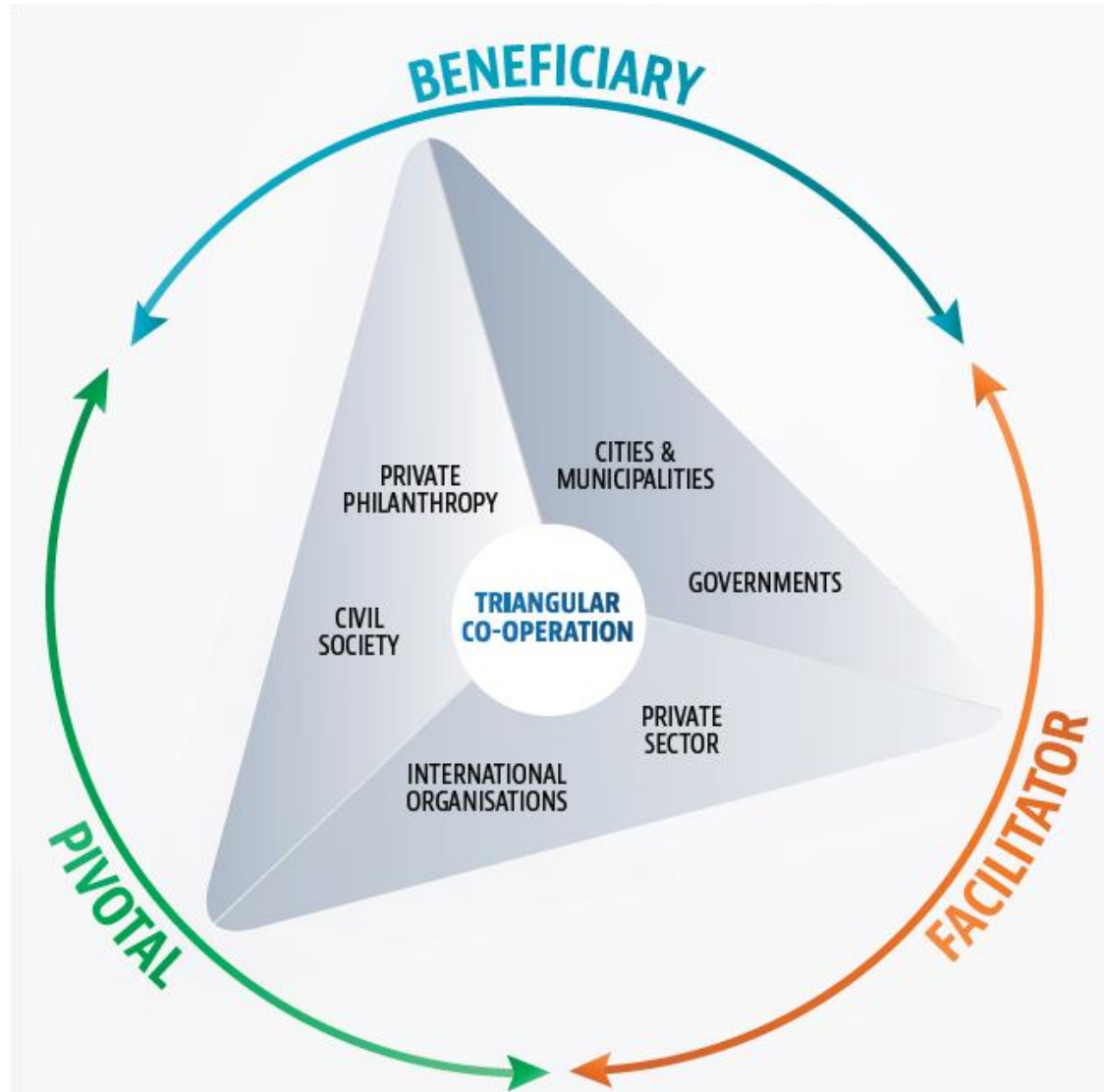
The GPI is a global initiative fostering the dynamic, innovative, and contemporary understanding of triangular co-operation.

What is the value added of triangular co-operation?

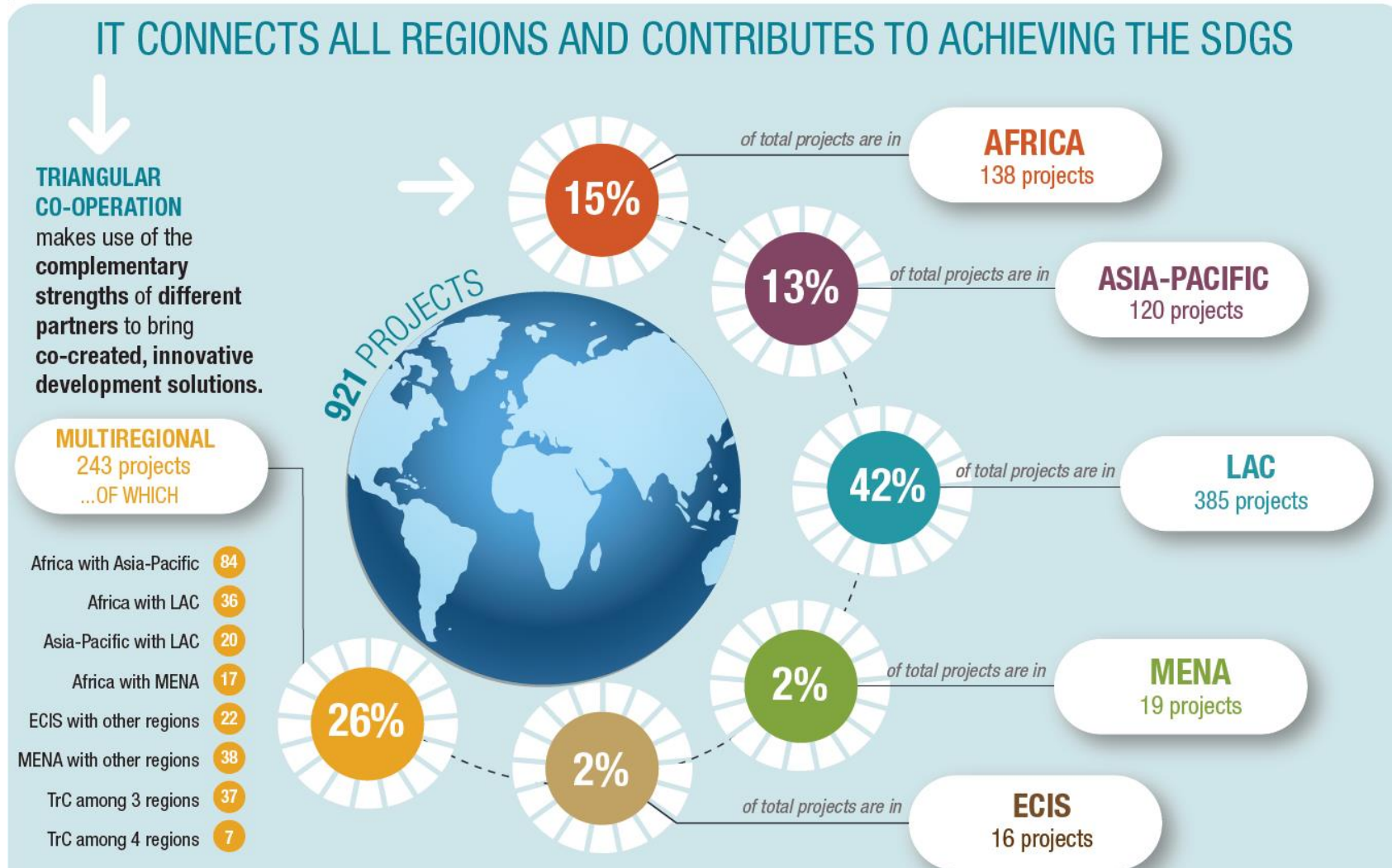
Triangular co-operation:

- delivers high impact results in issues such as climate change, gender equality and pandemic preparedness;
- forges real strategic and inclusive partnerships - by engaging in joint projects, we open doors for political dialogue and build vital trust.
- pools additional resources and transfers relevant knowledge - our contributions are leveraged through the resources of our partners. This leads to higher budgets, more partners, better expertise, and strong visibility.





Triangular co-operation worldwide

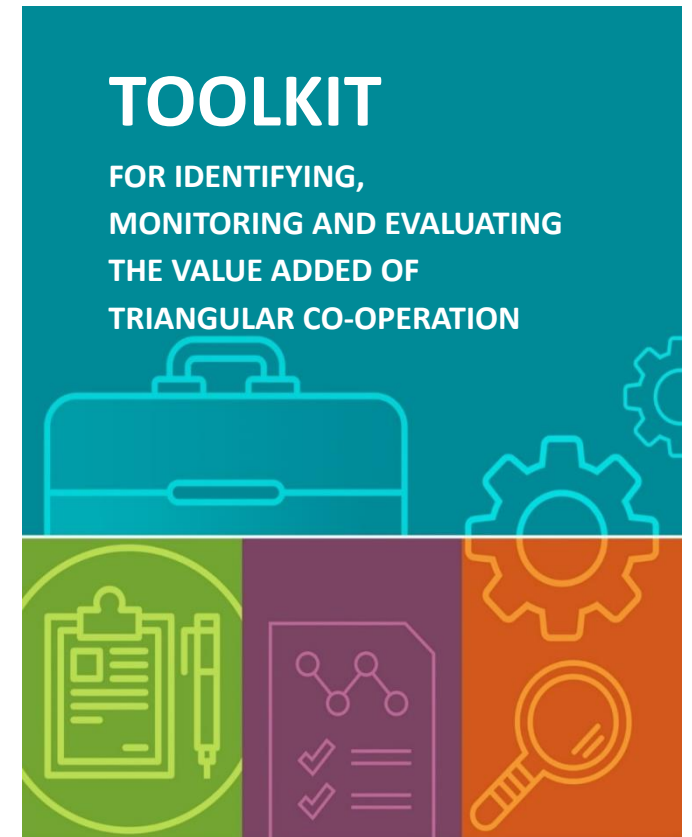

How is triangular co-operation different from bilateral and multilateral co-operation?

- In triangular co-operation we are investing in two things at the same time:
 - 1) projects, and
 - 2) partnerships.
- Transaction costs may seem high in the beginning but are an investment in partnership that pays back in the end.
